FWCC Oral Statement to be delivered at the 49th Session of the Human Rights Council Item 8 General Debate

FWCC (Quakers) wishes to take this opportunity to welcome report <u>49/88</u> on the contribution of [...] all human rights [...] to achieving the purposes and upholding the principles of the UN Charter - and its urge for 'revitalizing international solidarity and [...] cooperation'. **A call that cannot be understated in these rooms today.**

Its emphasis on human rights as an indispensable foundation for a peaceful, prosperous and just world and as a cornerstone to a new social contract are welcome. The persistent disconnect between Geneva and New York is however an ongoing concern to addressing cross-cutting and contemporary challenges.

In the spirit of the Charter, we therefore urge Member States to:

- Ensure human rights mechanisms are on a sustainable financial footing enabling the UN system to address prevention, foresight and reshape responses to violence with a human-rights based approach.
- Enhance engagement between the HRC and other intergovernmental organs including the PBC and Security Council to address cross-cutting issues from a prevention perspective and support countries in their efforts to build and sustain peace.
- Include peacebuilding and violence reduction practitioners in human rights processes and vis-versa, facilitated for instance by having prevention focal points at OHCHR, as knowledge and information nodes.
- Ensure relevant HRC reports including this report, <u>49/68</u> [on prevention & technical assistance],
 <u>48/21</u> on Special Procedures, <u>47/60</u> [on prevention] and <u>OHCHR's contributions to the PBA Review</u> are communicated and discussed in the New Agenda for Peace process.
